Job Description:

White Eagle Media is seeking a part-time driver to distribute its Spanish-language newspaper, La Vision. The newspaper is published monthly, and the initial distribution takes 2 workdays to complete and includes multiple stops / drop off locations in East Hartford, Hartford, New Britain, Waterbury, Bristol and Danbury. Occasionally, newspapers might have to be picked up from the printing facility in Springfield, MA.

Driver will be required to write down number of returns, if any, and the number of newspapers dropped off at each location. Driver will occasionally make decisions to increase or decrease number of newspapers being dropped off at a particular location and to engage with business owners or employees to secure the best location for the newspaper to be displayed.

Driver will be expected to recommend new drop off locations to continue to build out La Vision's distribution network.

After the initial drop off at all locations, the driver will make additional trips to high-volume locations to drop off more newspapers on the 2nd and 3rd week of the month.

Job Qualifications:

Candidate must have a valid driver license, a clean driving record and be able to lift newspaper bundles of up to 10 pounds.

Hours:

Initial distribution – 16 hours. Two additional trips to high volume locations at 4 hours each. 24 hours per month with more hours available as we expand our distribution network.

Compensation:

\$16 / hour using White Eagle Media car \$18 / hour using own car Reimbursement for gas (if using own car). Gas will be paid if using company car.
